

Lagerstroemia, "Muses of Helios", A few ground rules



- ✓ With Lagerstroemia, gardening becomes a real pleasure.
- ✓ These highly sought-after plants are much appreciated by garden-lovers.
- ✓ Choose the variety best suited to you for your garden or terrace.
- ✓ Please make sure its base stays dry in winter.
- ✓ Put the plant in the warmest and sunniest spot of your garden or terrace, protected from fierce winds.
- ✓ Trim it after the hardest frost and never after the end of July or in the autumn.
- ✓ No severe trimming is required in natural soil. Just some yearly clipping of the offshoots will do.
- ✓ Remember that Lagerstroemia takes a very long time to grow. Patience is a virtue and you will be amply rewarded.
- ✓ Should there be a long period of frost below -15°C, then it is advisable to cover or wrap the plant up at the bottom of the stem.
- ✓ Please protect young Lagerstroemias for at least the first 4 years during winter and ideally plant them in spring.

| Variety | Colour | Height | Description |
|------------------|-----------------|---------|---|
| X Acoma | White | 200/300 | Wide-hanging, dark brown foliage in autumn. |
| Baton Rouge | Pink-red | 100/150 | Spherically spread, rich flowerer. |
| Cordon Blue | Lilac | 50/100 | Low, hanging. |
| Delta Blush | Pink | 30/100 | Low, branched, early and rich flowerer. |
| X Hopi | Pink | 200/300 | Spherical, reliable early flowerer that blooms again. |
| Houston | Watermelon red | 40/60 | Branched, hanging, low variety. |
| Lafayette | Lavender white | 40/90 | Upright, hanging, very early and long flowerer. |
| Natchez | White | 700 | Vase-shaped, upright, attractive in winter. |
| Pink Velour | Bright pink | 300/360 | Broadly vase-shaped, one of the most hardy varieties. |
| Pixie White | White | 50/100 | Wide branches. Very remarkable and rich flowerer. |
| Rhapsody in Pink | Soft pink | 400/600 | Broadly vase-shaped, early and long flowerer. |
| X Tonto | Red | 250/300 | Spherical, branched. |
| X Tuscarora | Dark coral pink | 450/600 | Broadly vase-shaped, remarkable colour. |
| Victoria | Deep red | 150/200 | Upright, round, remarkable buds. |
| Worlds Fair | Watermelon red | 30/60 | Low, round, compact, hanging flowerer. |
